ENROLLMENT OPTIONS

Full season enrollment is for a total of seven weeks and the camp program is designed for this time. A limited number of campers are accepted on a "half-season basis" or for a period of 3-1/2 weeks. First half - June 24 - July 17. Second half - July 17 - August 10.

EARLY ENROLLMENT ADVANCE GUARD

Campers enrolled prior to January 1, 2004 will become members of the Advance Guard and will receive a W '04 lapel pin and an Advance Guard T-Shirt. A special trip is scheduled for the Advance Guard contingent each season.

TUTORING

Tutoring may be obtained in most subjects and is scheduled, whenever possible, not to interfere with the camper's regular routine. Two options are available: (1) two hours per week, or (2) three hours per week, at a rate of \$30.00 per hour. If you are uncertain whether tutoring will be necessary, please so indicate and our Director of Tutoring will contact you in early June to review final details and lesson materials. Tutoring is payable in advance.

GATHERINGS AND INTERVIEWS

Area gatherings are held in various metropolitan areas.

Schedules, including dates, time, and location will be mailed separately. Alumni, campers, prospects, and friends are cordially invited to attend. Special arrangements can be made at other times with prior notice.

TRAVEL

If numbers permit, chaperones from Winona and Wyonegonic will escort camper from Darien, Connecticut; Boston's Logan Airport, Manchester, N.H., and the Portland (Maine) Jetport via chartered buses or vans. International campers are met the day before each session begins, lodged overnight at an airport hotel, and travel to camp the following day in our chartered buses. Campers are also chaperoned on their return trip to Darien, and are placed on their flights home at Boston's Logan Airport, Manchester, N.H., and the Portland (Maine) Jetport by camp chaperons.

VISITING

The camp is closed to visitors from June 24 through July 3, (for second half campers, please do not visit prior to July 27). This allows campers a reasonable time to adjust to the camp routine. The camp is also closed to visitors from August 6 until Awards Night, 7:00 PM, August 9 to allow the boys to fully enjoy end of season activities.

Parents are cordially invited to visit between July 4 and August 7 (second half, see note above) and are welcome to join us for our Saturday night cookouts. Those wishing to take their own children out for a meal may make arrangements with the Unit Directors.

CAMP OUTFIT

There is a minimum required camp outfit of regulation shorts and shirts for all campers.

The Amerasport Company, Newton Lower Falls, MA, <www.Amerasport.com> makes a specialty of outfitting boys' and girls' camps, and our outfit is purchased through them. Order and measurement blanks with price list will be sent in due time after a camper is enrolled. Orders should be placed as early as possible to ensure delivery of articles at home before camp opens.

ALL CLOTHING AND ALL OTHER ARTICLES SHOULD BE PLAINLY MARKED WITH NAME IN FULL.

SEWED-ON NAME TAPES FOR CLOTHING ARE RECOMMENDED.

FOOTLOCKERS

Footlockers are recommended in order to store clothing at camp. Where possible we will ship campers' trunks home by United Parcel Service. UPS can handle only those footlockers which weigh less than 150 pounds and measure less than 130 inches (girth plus length). The footlockers sold by Amerasport meet these specifications.

UNIT ASSIGNMENT

Each unit offers its own facilities and programs suited to the age and ability of its campers. A unit director, head counselor, tent and activity staff are retained specifically for each group. Sometimes final unit assignments for campers will not be made until after April 1st. This allows us to accept a full enrollment and to assure that your son will be with boys within his own age group.

Pre-camp Information to Parents is mailed to parents of enrolled campers monthly from February - June. Also furnished will be chaperoned party and trunk shipping information, plus a listing of area accommodations.
