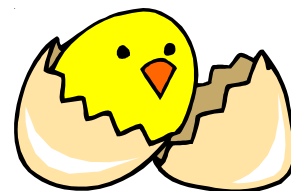
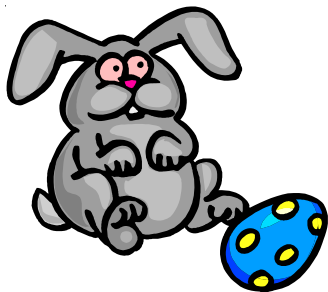


Happy Easter

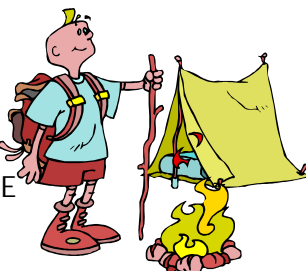

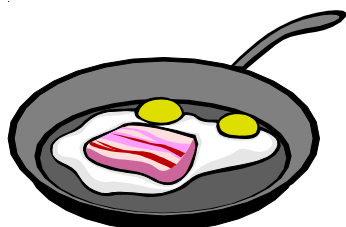
