2018 CAMP SEASON

Opens on Wednesday, June 27 and closes on Tuesday, August 14.

ENROLLMENT OPTIONS

Full season enrollment is for a total of seven weeks and the camp program is designed for this time period. A limited number of campers are accepted on a "half-season basis" or for a period of 3-1/2 weeks. First Half - June 27 - July 21. Second Half - July 21 - August 14.

EARLY ENROLLMENT ADVANCE GUARD

Campers enrolled prior to January 1, 2018 will become members of the Advance Guard and will receive an Advance Guard T-Shirt. A special trip is scheduled for the Advance Guard contingent each session.

REGISTRATION DEPOSIT REFUND POLICY

\$100 of the \$500 deposit is a service charge and is non-refundable. The balance of \$400 is refundable if notified before February 1, 2018. There are no deposit refunds after February 1. Once your son's session has begun, there are no tuition refunds, but you may request to "roll over" the tuition for the next session or next summer.

TUITION

Tuition not only covers room, board, program and staff instruction, but also postage, laundry, bedding, stationery, camp pictures, address book, special transportation for out-of-camp trips, candy, horseback riding, and health center care in camp.

TRAVEL

If numbers permit, chaperons from Winona and Wyonegonic will escort campers from Greenwich, Connecticut; Boston's Logan Airport, and the Portland (Maine) Jetport via chartered buses or vans. International campers are met the day before each session begins, lodged overnight at an airport hotel, and travel to camp the following day in our chartered buses. Campers are also chaperoned on their return trip to Greenwich, CT, and are placed on their flights home at Boston's Logan Airport, and the Portland (Maine) Jetport by camp chaperons.

VISITING

The camp is closed to visitors from June 27 through and including July 6, (for second half campers, please do not visit prior to July 31st). This allows campers a reasonable time to adjust to the camp routine. The camp is also closed to visitors from August 11 until Awards Night, 7:00 PM, August 13 to allow the boys to fully enjoy the end of season activities.

Parents are cordially invited to visit between July 7 and August 10 (second half, see note above) and are welcome to join us for our Saturday night cookouts. Those wishing to take their own children out for a meal may make arrangements with the Winona Office.

COMMUNICATION

Winona campers are encouraged to write letters, but they do not have access to email, or phones (exception is made if a camper has a birthday while at camp). Further information about communicating with your son can be found in the Parents Guide.

SPRING DETAILS

Pre-camp information is mailed to parents of enrolled campers monthly from February - June, including our *Parents' Guide*, transportation information and trunk shipping information. More details regarding Winona's policies and procedures can be found at our website: www.winonacamps.com.

CAMP OUTFIT

There is a minimum required camp outfit of regulation shorts and shirts for all campers. The Amerasport Company, Holliston, MA, www.Amerasport.com makes a specialty of outfitting boys' and girls' camps, and our outfit is purchased through them. Order and measurement blanks with price list will be sent in due time after a camper is enrolled. Orders should be placed as early as possible to ensure delivery of articles at home before camp opens.

ALL CLOTHING AND ALL OTHER ARTICLES SHOULD BE PLAINLY MARKED WITH CAMPER'S NAME IN FULL.

TRUNKS

Trunks are recommended in order to store clothing at camp. Where possible we will ship campers' trunks home by The Mailing Center, Inc. They can handle only those trunks which weigh less than 150 pounds and measure less than 130 inches (girth plus length). The trunks sold by Amerasport meet these specifications. Go to www.mailingctr.com for shipping instructions.

UNIT ASSIGNMENT

Each unit offers its own facilities and programs suited to the age and ability of its campers. A unit director, head counselor, tent and activity staff are retained specifically for each group. Sometimes final unit assignments for campers will not be made until after June 1st. This allows us to accept a full enrollment and to assure that your son will be with boys within his own age group.
