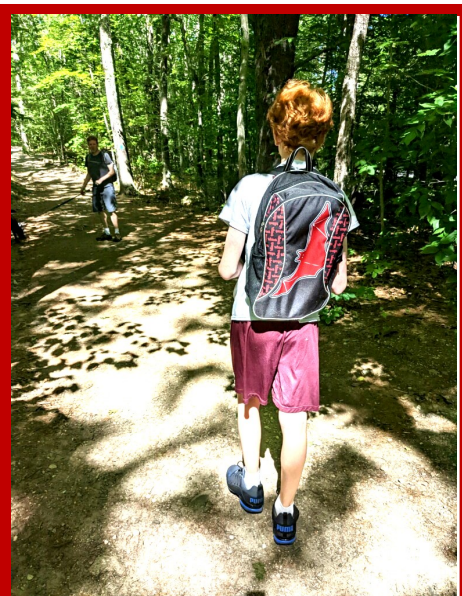

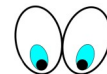

We had such a great summer and we are already planning for next summer. Winona is making a significant change to our calendar. Not only will we be starting camp several days earlier than we have traditionally, but the entire season is changing from a 7-week session to a 6-week session (with two, 3-week options for "half session campers"). Due to our shortened calendar we expect sessions to fill quickly and encourage you to enroll early.

You've heard of an "early bird special", well this is an Early BAT special: Families wishing to pay-in-full prior to September 15, 2022 will receive early enrollment discounts for FULL session.

Next month Winona will send CIT "Invitation To Apply" packets. The packet will be sent to boys who qualify based upon their success as a camper and who will be age 16 before July 1 (or who will have completed 10th grade by next summer). Remember that this "Invitation to Apply" is not acceptance. A completed and thorough application, outside references along with recent camper evaluations are all considered in the CIT selection process.
